Friday 3 November

Peppermint Bay Cruise \$148pp

Our theme for the conference is Tasmania – including flora and fauna, and our history. In line with this we have now organised a pre-conference cruise on Friday 3 November to give you a feel for the wonderful scenery, sea life and produce in Tasmania. This is a round trip scenic cruise to Peppermint Bay, starting at 10.00am. The cruise pauses at points of interest: ancient rock formations and sea life such as sea eagles, dolphins, and seals. Lunch is provided at the Peppermint Bay Hotel overlooking Bruny Island. The cruise then returns to Hobart, arriving at 3.30pm.



Monday 6 November

Huon valley \$150pp

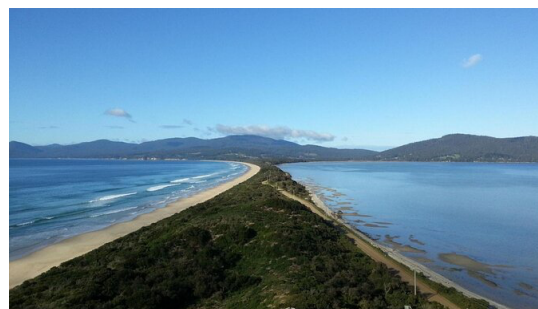


Travelling through the Huon River Valley, you will learn about the region's agriculture, drive beside forest clad rivers and through fishing villages set by picturesque inlets. Pass through the town of Huonville and Franklin, the home of wooden boat building. Stop at the country town of Geeveston before heading deep into the Tasmanian Forest.

The Tahune Airwalk, offering stunning views of the canopy of Tasmanian cool temperate rainforest, native timbers and wild rivers. This is flat walking and wheelchair accessible. The last stop is Willie Smith's Cider and Apple Shed. Learn the history of the apple orchards, once an important industry of the region

Bruny Island \$150pp

Discover the scenic coastline, beaches, national parks, flora, and fauna of Bruny Island on this full-day tour from Hobart. Travel via ferry to the island (tickets included), and walk through the temperate rain forest, stop at a viewing platform at the Neck, and sample locally made products. Spend the day on famous Bruny Island. Round-trip ferry transfers included.
